Due to the complexities of Brazil no one under the age of 17 should apply for World Youth Day 2013 in Rio. I rely on your assistance and vigilance in respecting this requirement. Further to this age requirement anyone who is not 18 by June 1, 2013 must have a parent as a guardian to travel with the diocesan group to Rio.
