- Father Malcolm DeWeese, Jr., who is in his seventy-fifth year, will be retiring May 11, 2010 and returning to the United States. Father is an American citizen and studied and ordained for the Diocese of Kamloops on September 1, 1996. Father has served Immaculate Heart of Mary - Cache Creek (1996-1997); rector of Sacred Heart Cathedral (1996-1999); St. Ann's - Quesnel (1999-2005); Immaculate Heart of Mary - Cache Creek, St. Gerard's - Ashcroft and St. Peter's - Clinton (2006-2010).
- Father Nicholas Forde, OMI came to the Diocese of Kamloops in 2002. He will be retiring and leaving the Diocese of Kamloops on June 17, 2010. While in the Diocese he served the Parishes of St. George, Barriere; Saint James, Clearwater, St. John the Baptist, Chu Chua and St. Mary's, Squam Bay (2002-2007) and Holy Family, Kamloops (2005-2010).
- Father Domingo Cedo, because of serious illness has requested to return to the Philippines to be with his family. He returned to the Philippines on April 28th, 2010. Father was ordained for the Archdiocese of Caceres, Philippines and came to the Diocese of Calgary in 1984. In 2001 Father Domingo came to the Diocese of Kamloops. While in the Diocese Father served at Saint James, Vernon (2001 to 2005) and Sacred Heart - Merritt, St. Michael's - Logan Lake, Our Lady of Lourdes - Quilchena and Saint Paul's - Coldwater (2005 to 2010).
