**In Memory Father Patrick Skaria, O.S.A.** Father Patrick Skaria, O.S.A. died on December 30, 2011 at Marylake Monastery, King City, Ontario. He was born in Kerela, India on February 13, 1941. He joined the Order of Saint Augustine in India and later went to the Philippines for his Novitiate in Manila in 1971. He professed his vows on April 30, 1972 and was ordained to the priesthood on June 28, 1975. Father came to Canada in the mid-eighties and worked in several dioceses in British Columbia, including the Diocese of Kamloops where he served at Enderby, Pemberton and Mount Currie until he went to the Diocese of Nelson in 2005. When Father retired 2010 he stayed at the rectory of Christ the Servant parish in Cranbrook, B.C. and in November 2011 while dealing with his ill health he went to Marylake Shrine where he died on December 30, 2011. The funeral Mass was on January 3, 2012 at Marylake Shrine.
