A CHRISTMAS PRAYER

Oh my Lord,

I pray for all who suffer, especially at this time of year; those who feel lonely, lost, frightened, isolated, unworthy, abused, unappreciated, in pain, and unloved. May Your Holy Spirit cover them in peace, anoint them, heal them from their brokenness and mend their bruised hearts.. Be with them in the lonely hours; help them not to feel marginalized during this season that places so much emphasis on 'family' and comfort them as You are our true family.

I pray for those who are unable to leave their homes or hospital rooms due to illness, for those who suffer debilitating pain and constant suffering, and those awaiting operations. Bring wholeness, peace, and calm into these fragile lives, bring release, even for a little while, and healing.

I pray for those painfully separated from loved ones due to work, duty or other circumstances. Watch between them when they are out of one another's sight and bind them together in your love. Be the bond that keeps them together.

I pray for families and individuals who are struggling financially and emotionally. Remove their anxieties and fears and replace them with faith and peace and open new doors for them so they may face the future with renewed courage.

I pray for children who are frightened and alone, whose childhood has been stolen from them due to war, prostitution, slavery, or abuse. Fill their emptiness, heal their wounds, free them from fear, bring them to safety, and restore them to true health. Turn the hearts of abusers and exploiters and by your Spirit bring them to true repentance and amendment of life. I pray for parents who have children who are ill in body or in mind. Give them Your strength and love, and especially Your presence. Remind them that You understand the suffering of a beloved child.

I pray for those struggling with addictions. Let them see that You are what they crave, and envelop them in the warm blanket of Your eternal love and protect them. I pray for all whose lives have been touched by death or tragedy. Immerse them in Your love and lead them through this darkness into your arms, and light.

Jesus, please come, please enter into each place, each home, each hospital room, each homeless shelter, each hotel, each jail cell, each place of business - let them know they are not alone. Holy Spirit, come as the Comforter, let Your gentle, healing warmth soothe and bring solace to aching hearts. Amen
