Tax Receipt 2019 reminder for parishioners: Faith in Action donations must be received in the Faith in Action office by Tuesday Dec 31 (before the banks close/or office closes). **Donations at this point should be mailed directly to the Faith in Action office to be eligible for 2019 tax receipt.** All donations received after the banks close on December 31, or are post marked later than December 31, will go toward 2020 Tax Receipt. If you leave your Faith in Action donation at the parish office you are risking that it will not be included in your 2019 tax receipt. Likewise, if you plan to attend another parish between now and the end of the year, or at Christmas, please bring your offering envelope directly to the parish office if you require your donation to be on your 2019 tax receipt as per CRA directives. The General Instructions of the Roman Missal (GRIM) says in paragraph 98. "The acolyte is instituted for service at the altar and to assist the Priest and Deacon. It is his place principally to prepare the altar and the sacred vessels and, if necessary, to distribute the Eucharist to the faithful as an extraordinary minister. In the ministry of the altar, the acolyte has his own proper functions (cf. nos. 187-193), which he must carry out in person." Following the Mass and installation we will have a social gathering in the parish Hall. All are welcome to attend. **Please continue to pray for Dominic as he continues throughout each stage of priestly formation.**
