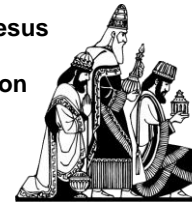

GOOD SHEPHERD TRAINING OPPORTUNITY:

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd Formation Leaders, Debi Zeni and Caroline-Marie Petch, will be coming to Kamloops this **March 16-21, 2020** to provide training for the Level 1 for adults working with the 3-6 year old child in a parish or school setting. The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd is a Christian religious formation for children starting at the age of 3. It seeks to nurture the children's relationship with God in a sacred space called an atrium; a place fashioned after a Montessori educational environment that includes 'hands-on' materials, in which both the children and their catechists can listen, ponder and celebrate the most profound mysteries of the Christian faith as revealed in Scripture and Liturgy. Founded in Rome by Sofia Cavalletti and Gianna Gobbi in 1954, the Catechesis has spread world-wide and is used by various Christian traditions to nurture the child's

relationship with Jesus. The course is presented in the Roman Catholic tradition but includes awareness of material adaptations to the Anglican, Lutheran and Orthodox traditions. There are three levels of training for adults interested in the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd: Level 1 for children 3-6 years of age Level 2 for children 6-9 years of age Level 3 for children 9-12 years of age. Holy days of obligation are feast days on which Catholics are required to attend Mass and to avoid (to the extent that they are able) servile work. Holy Days of obligation to be observed in Canada are: all Sundays of the year, Christmas Day and the Feast of Mary, Mother of God (January 1).

Please join us at Sacred Heart Cathedral on January 4th at 7 pm as Bishop Joseph installs seminarian Dominic Rosario into the ministry of acolyte. The General Instructions of the Roman Missal (GRIM) says in paragraph 98. "The acolyte is instituted for service at the altar and to assist the Priest and Deacon. It is his place principally to prepare the altar and the sacred vessels and, if necessary, to distribute the Eucharist to the faithful as an extraordinary minister. In the ministry of the altar, the acolyte has his own proper functions (cf. nos. 187-193), which he must carry out in person." Following the Mass and installation we will have a social gathering in the parish Hall. All are welcome to attend. **Please continue to pray for Dominic as he continues throughout each stage of priestly formation**
