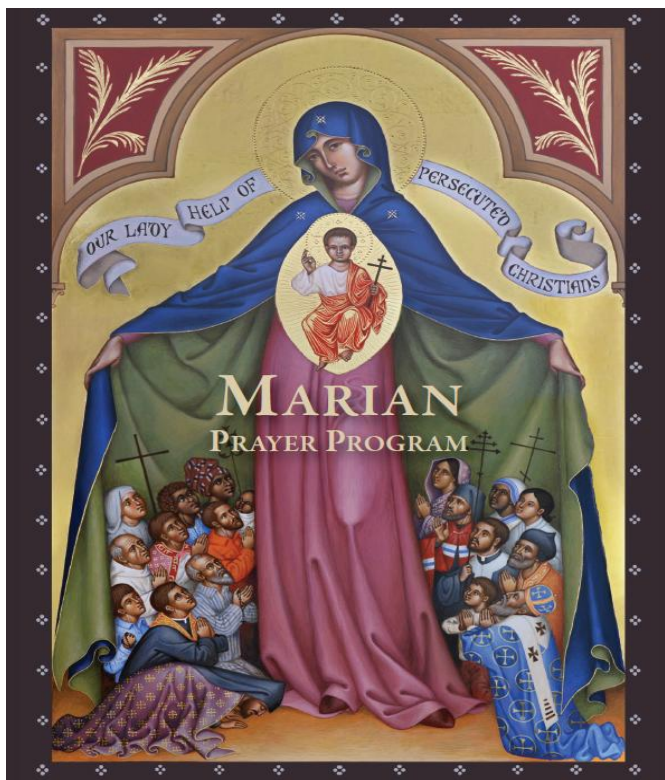

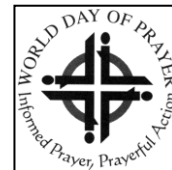


February 27, 2019 please join us for a special prayer event in support of persecuted Christians. The 2018-2019 Marian Prayer Program presents the 18th Marian image sponsored by the Knights of Columbus, this time of Our Lady Help of Persecuted Christians. This year, the prayer service is intended to raise awareness of the plight of Christians persecuted for their faith and to stand in prayerful solidarity with them. There are many countries where a single religion is imposed or where there is violent persecution or systematic cultural mockery of the disciples of Jesus, denying them religious freedom, which, the Pope said, is a fundamental human right that must be recognized because it reflects man's highest dignity. Pope Francis is encouraging prayers so that Christians who find themselves in difficult conditions can prove themselves strong in the face of trials, feeling the closeness of the entire Catholic community, so they can be a seed of new vitality and hope for the Church. Our Holy Father has encouraged all people to pray for those who continue to be persecuted in an effort to form greater solidarity with our brothers and sisters in Christ. Pope Francis asks each of us to embrace those who are persecuted with our prayers and remember their suffering and Pope Francis reminds all Christians that although there are differences in faith or in traditions, those differences shouldn't outweigh the respect and patience we should have for one another. **The community is invited to a prayer service for persecuted Christians on Wednesday, Feb 27th beginning with Mass at 6:30 pm, music provided by the Men's Choir, followed by the Rosary and then Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament until 8:45 when Evening Prayer will be offered with Benediction at 9 pm. 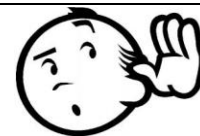

ARE YOU HAVING TROUBLE HEARING AT MASS?

We have a couple of ideas that could possibly be helpful, but we ask for your input. Possible solutions, if there is sufficient need, include a hearing loop or headphones.

Hearing Loop: For those who have not experienced a hearing loop system in a church, a hearing loop (also known as an induction loop) is a wireless device technology that works with telecoil hearing aids (almost all new hearing aids now have telecoils) and all cochlear implants to produce clear sound without feedback or background noise. Consisting of only three parts – an amplifier, microphone and very thin loop wire – hearing loops create a magnetic field that is picked up by any t-coil equipped hearing aid and converted to audible sound. If your hearing aid does not have telecoils you can have your audiologist install them on your hearing aid.

A personal assisted listening system allows listeners to use a personal audio device to listen to the mix from a sound reinforcement system. Hearing assist systems typically consist of a wireless transmitter that connects to a mixing console or digital signal processor and wireless receivers that pick up the
